



## Support legislation to implement pension increases, strengthen ERS and TRS pension funds

BILL#	SPONSOR	DESCRIPTION
HB 9	Rep. Greg Bonnen	Increases state contribution to TRS and provides a 13th check to retirees, maximum of \$2,500
HB 425	Rep. Alma Allen	Increases the monthly benefit of ERS retirees by 10% and provides for a 4% annual cost of living adjustment. <i>Referred to the House Pensions Committee.</i>
HB 426	Rep. Alma Allen	Increases the monthly benefit of TRS retirees by 10% and provides for a 4% annual cost of living adjustment. <i>Referred to the House Pensions Committee.</i>
HB 56 HB 398 HB 597	Rep. Armando Martinez Rep. Ana Hernandez Rep. Sergio Munoz	These bills require TRS to adjust pension payments annually based on the increase in the cost of living determined by the US government. <i>All have been referred to the House Pensions Committee.</i>
HB 596	Rep. Ana Hernandez	Allows a retired state employee to serve on ERS board of trustees. <i>Referred to Pensions Committee. Heard in Committee on March 5th, TSEU ROC Activist Leroy Haverlah testified, voted favorably from committee.</i>
HB 2505	Rep. Steve Allison	Directs funding from the Economic Stabilization Fund to the TRS
HB 3662	Rep. Armando Walle	Adds a Higher Education designated seat to the TRS board of trustees. <i>Referred to Pensions Committee</i>

SB 92	Sen. Jose Menendez	Authorizes a 13 <sup>th</sup> month check to TRS members if the pension fund is actuarially sound. <i>Referred to the State Affairs Committee.</i>
SB 93	Sen. Jose Menendez	Authorizes a 3% or \$100 a month, whichever is less, cost of living adjustment (COLA) for TRS retirees who retired between 2004 and 2015. <i>Referred to the State Affairs Committee.</i>
SB 94 HB 2295	Sen. Jose Menendez Rep. Terry Canales	Raises the state minimum contribution to the TRS pension fund from 6% to 7%. <i>Referred to the State Affairs Committee and House Pensions Committee.</i>
SB 252	Sen. Pat Fallon	Authorizes a 3% or \$100 a month, whichever is less, COLA for TRS retirees who retired between 2004 and 2017. <i>Referred to the State Affairs Committee.</i>
SB 1862 SJR 60	Sen. Jose Menendez	Raises the state maximum contribution to the ERS pension fund from 10 percent of payroll to 11 percent. <i>Referred to the State Affairs Committee.</i>
